## HELPFUL TIPS

There's a lot going on in Lincoln that can help seniors continue to thrive at home and through safe social distances. Check out these local resources:

- HyVee has dedicated 7-8 a.m. each day for senior-dedicated hours to shop. There's also free full-service fueling at their gas stations.
